Program:

Duration of the Programme:

Ph.D. programme (including course work) will be for a minimum duration of three years and a maximum of six years.

Extension beyond the above limits will be governed by the relevant clauses as stipulated in the Statute/Ordinance of the MIT ADT University.

The women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) will be allowed a relaxation of two years for Ph.D. in the maximum duration. In addition, the women candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of M.Phil/Ph.D. for up to 240 days.

Procedure for admission:

MIT ADT University shall admit Ph.D. students through its Ph.D. Entrance Test.

MIT-ADT University, Pune shall conduct PET on annual basis with predetermined schedule through its academic bodies and manageable number of Ph.D. scholars will be admitted depending on the number of available Research Supervisors and other academic and physical facilities, keeping in mind the norms regarding the scholar teacher ratio, laboratory, library and such other facilities notifying well in advance in the institutional website and through advertisement in at least two (2) national newspapers, of which at least one (1) shall be in the regional language, the number of seats for admission, subject/discipline-wise distribution of available seats, criteria for admission, procedure for admission, examination centre(s) where entrance test(s) will be conducted and all other relevant information for the benefit of the candidates;

Admission will be by two stage process through:

- An Entrance Test shall be qualifying with qualifying marks as 50%. The syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50% of research methodology and 50% shall be subject specific.
- An interview/viva-voce which will be organized by the University. The candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted. Department Research Committee. The interview/viva voce will also consider the following aspects, viz. whether: (a) The candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research; (b) The research work can be suitably undertaken at the Institution/College; (c) The proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.
- MIT ADT University, Pune will maintain the list of all the Ph.D. registered students on its website on year-wise basis. The list will include the name of the registered

candidate, topic of his/her research, name of his/her supervisor/co supervisor, date of enrolment/registration.

Eligibility

- Candidates for admission to the Ph.D. programme shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.
- A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the

relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

- Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. Course work with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and successfully completing the M.Phil. Degree shall be eligible to proceed to do research work leading to the Ph. D. Degree in the same Institution in an integrated programme. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/differently abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.
- A person whose M.Phil. Dissertation has been evaluated and the viva voce is pending may be admitted to the Ph.D. programme of the same Institution;
- Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M.Phil. Degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme.

Format for Examination:

The examination will be of 200 marks bifurcated as 100 marks theory examination and 100 marks Viva.

The theory exam paper will comprise of two sections: Section I & Section II.

Section I will include questions on Research Methodology & Research Aptitude. The paper pattern will be as follows:
